

## **AIMS Scores for Happy Valley School (Spring, 2011)**

The results below represent the percentage of students whose scores fell into the two "Passing" categories ("Meets the Standard" and "Exceeds the Standard") on the AIMS Test. The passing rate for all Happy Valley students is reported for each grade level. Test results for all students who took the test in Arizona are also presented in the tables below. The data below was provided to us by the test publisher and scoring company. This information was embargoed from public dissemination until Wednesday, July 13 to allow for challenges and corrections by schools, but it should be correct.

Based on test results from 2010, Happy Valley School was again designated an "Excelling" Arizona school for the fourth consecutive year. Our 2011 spring test results look promising for us to maintain that standing, but the final results will not be released by the Department of Education until July 27.

## **Stanford 10 Scores for Happy Valley School (Spring, 2011)**

Scores on the Stanford 10 are reported by percentile rankings. A score of 65<sup>th</sup> percentile means that the student(s) scored as well as, or higher than, 65 percent of all students at that grade level who took the test. The **50<sup>th</sup> percentile** is established by averaging the tests scores for all students who took the tests nationally. Rankings for our students are presented in the table below, but rankings for all students in Arizona are not available at this time.

The table below indicates that the average scores for our students in second grade were at or above the 74<sup>th</sup> percentile in reading; at or above the 81<sup>st</sup> percentile in Math: and, at or above the 74<sup>th</sup> percentile in Language (grammar). Locally, we use scores to identify opportunities to improve instruction in different subject areas, not necessarily to define each individual student's ability. Individual scores do help show how each student performs in relation to other students in his/her class.
